LENTEN PENANCE SERVICE...St. Philip's Lenten Penance Service will be held on **Wednesday, March 30** at 6:30 pm.

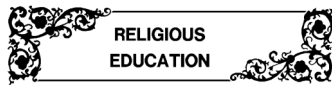
CATHOLIC DAUGHTERS OF AMERICA YARD
